CZECH O-TOUR 2022 - Jizerky

Welcome to the second round of the Czech O-Tour series, which returns to the places where the World Orienteering Championship took place last year. After Terezín in March, we will welcome the competitors to the Jizera Mountains in the vicinity of Buková hora. What have we prepared?

1. start lists, results, descriptions, starting numbers will be available only at the arena in Josefův Důl; at the Tanvaldský Špičák autocamp there is only accommodation, Friday night race and Saturday concert of the Good Water Band (from 18:00)
2. all maps will be printed on waterproof pretex, but this does not mean that the map cannot be destroyed - use any additional packaging (to a limited extent they will be at the start)
3. control descriptions will be available (as opposed to Terezín) in printed form before each race
4. Together with a number of partners, we have prepared gifts after completing all three races at the finish
5. a number of sports stands (O-RUN, Sporticus, GemMedic, O-land, KYLIE SPORT STUDIO, Lucifer, Kazboš, Haven, SIGN-SPORT) will be at your disposal throughout the event

The organizers from Czech Orienteering Federation and OOB TJ Tatran Jablonec wish you nice sports and cultural experiences.

Arena: Ski Resort Josefův Důl, 50.7739828N, 15.2359122E

Event Office: for late entries and changes on the spot and to collect the accommodation wristbands; **who has everything properly paid and is not accommodated in the camp, does not need to go to the Event Office!**

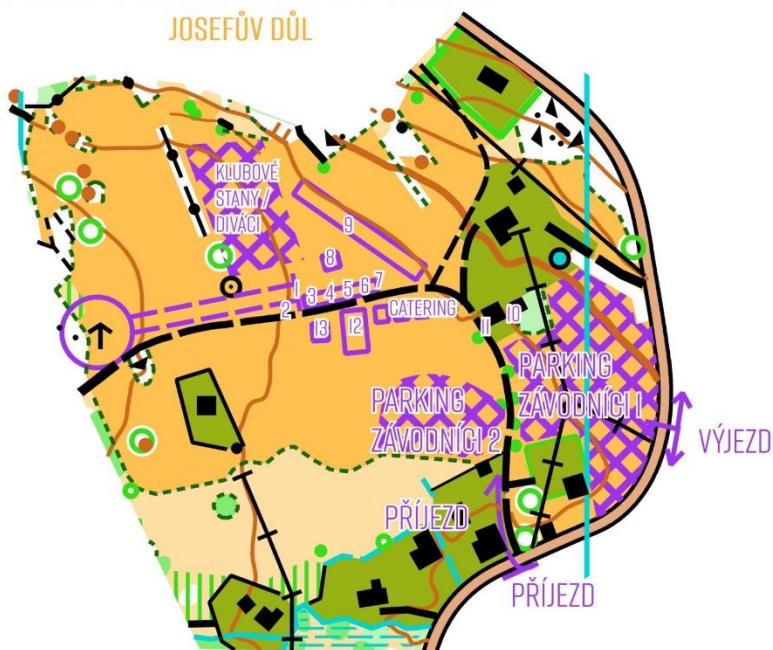

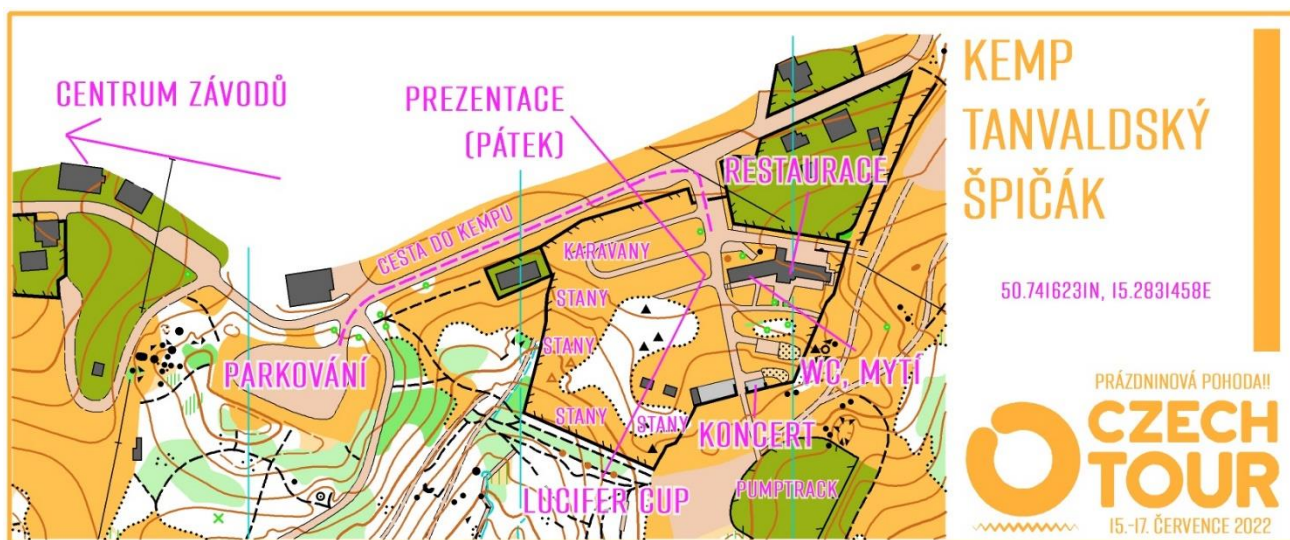

Accommodation:

Competitors or clubs that have booked at the Tanvaldský Špičák camp must first go to the Event Office to collect a special wristband, without which it is not possible to overnight there.

Control descriptions: self-service collection at the arena, in the map

Starting numbers: each competitor collects the starting number at the arena (the same for all 3 races)

Parking: At the arena in the Ski Resort Josefův Důl. Follow the instructions of the organizers.
50 CZK fee for the whole weekend.

Terrain: challenging Jizera Mountains terrain with a number of rocks, stones and clusters

- Forbidden areas: Strict ban on entering private land. Prohibition of overcoming the 518 map symbol "impassable fence". In the map there is an overwintering preserve with two clear entrances along the way.
- Mandatory marked route: Start – map start (beginning of orientation) and last control - finish. Marked with red-and-white tape pieces.
- Refreshment, meals: At the finish, water and ionic drink Ionilyte for all competitors.
At the arena a rich selection of meals and drinks (vegetarian food, grill, lemonade, beer, etc.).
- Marked courses: Courses of D10L, H10L and HDR classes are marked with red and white tape pieces, shortening between control points is allowed. In the HDR class there are 2 maps (1st for the competitor and 2nd for the accompanying person).
Accompaniment is only allowed in the HDR class. In public classes, it is possible to run according to the selected class in pairs, or the whole family / group together.
- Start lists: available in ORIS, on the race website, in the OTour application and posted at the arena
- Punching system: Electronic, SportIdent units will be set to beacon non-contact mode, including finish units (allowing punching up to a distance of 0.5 m). In the starting corridor, it is mandatory to clear the chip (CLEAR unit) and perform a zeroing check (CHECK, starting the contactless punching). When the finish unit is punched, the contactless punching is turned off. In the case of a failure of the SI units, the competitor is obliged to mark the control into the map. The competitor is obliged to hand over the map for inspection at the finish. Time is measured with an accuracy of whole seconds.

Possibility to borrow a SI-chip (not SIAC) for a fee of 50, -CZK / race, in case of loss of the borrowed chip the price of 800, -CZK will be charged. Requirements for chip rental should be stated in the entry.
- Finish: Maps will not be collected; we ask for fair play. **After reaching the finish, the competitor is obliged to read out the chip, even if the race is not completed.** The finish will be closed after the maximum running time of the last starting competitor has expired.
- Preliminary results: will be continuously posted at the arena and available online via the Otour app. The final results will be published in the ORIS system and on the series website.
- Prize giving: Announcement of the winners of Saturday's races on Saturday preliminarily at 18:30. On Sunday, the announcement is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. Only the winners will be announced. Always at the arena in Josefův Důl. In the HDR, D10L, D10, H10L and H10 classes, each participant will receive a small reward for completing each race.
- Kindergarten: at the arena for the necessary time when parents compete, see the map
- WC: 14 pcs of mobile toilets TOI TOI at the arena
- Changing clothes: the organizer does not provide, it is possible to set up club tents at the arena
- Washing: basic washing in plastic wash basins close to the arena
- First aid: at the arena on both days (Mountain Rescue Service Jizera Mountains)
- Course parameters: are published in the start lists

- Mobile apps OTour: Download in [Google Play](#) (for Android) and AppStore (for iPhone). After entering the registration number, it displays the start time, preliminary and overall results, as well as tips for trips in the surroundings.
- Protests: A protest against violation of non-compliance with the Rules or against the decision of the controller can be submitted in writing (no later than 30 minutes after the planned

time of closing the finish), on the spot and supported by a deposit of CZK 400 to the controller.

Protest against the official results then in writing within 14 days of the publication of the official results – by e-mail to m.janata@atlas.cz, with a deposit of CZK 400 sent to the organizer's account.

Regulation: The event is held according to the valid Czech orienteering Rules. Estimated running times of the winners can be found on the event website: <https://o-tour.cz/en/info-2/classes/>

Notice: Everyone participates in the race at his/her own risk, the organizers of the race do not assume any responsibility. In the stone fields, watch out for holes and depressions, especially in blueberries.

The operation of sales or promotional activities is possible only with the consent of the event director.

Protection of personal data: The organizer, as a personal data administrator, is entitled to process the personal data of the registered participant for the fulfillment of his/her duties as the organizer of the race, for the purpose of fulfilling the contract that occurs between the organizer and the participant of the race by accepting the entry. For the purpose of fulfilling its obligations, the organizer will publish the participant's personal data in the valid CSOS format in the form of an entry, start list and results in the ORIS information system (<https://oris.orientacnisporty.cz/>) and on the event website (<https://o-tour.cz>).

Photography: During the event, news photographs will be taken to inform the public about the race, billing subsidies for the event, etc. in accordance with Section 89 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code. In addition, photos can be taken for the personal use of the competitors (as a memory of the races, to promote your club etc.) especially from the medal ceremony and the finish. In case you do not agree with the shooting, please explicitly notify the photographer.

Terrain: suburban forest, meadows, partly rocky, dense network of paths

Map: Pod kempem, 1 : 4 000, by Jiří Vištejn and Jan Picek, July 2022, size A4, map is printed on waterproof material PRETEX

Special map symbols: black cross – monkey bars, other man-made feature
black circle – electricity pole, shaft
green cross – root stock
blue star - shaft

Control descriptions: only in the map

Refreshment: 0.5 l bottle of drinking water at the finish

WC: at the camp

Preliminary results: will be continuously posted at the arena. The final results will be published in the ORIS system and on the event website.

Gifts for participants: For all participants who finish the race, there is a 10% discount on all headlamps produced by Lucifer. If you beat Lucifer owner Petr Dvořák in a long-distance race (3 km), then you will have a 15% discount.

Announcement: The winner is not the one with the best time, but everyone has a chance. Of all the competitors who will reach the finish line and will not be DISK, we will draw three lucky ones who will win valuable prizes from the Lucifer company. The evaluation will take place on Saturday at approximately 18:30 before the announcement of the winners E1 and E2 in Josefův Důl.
