#### News 2024

We have prepared a number of new features for 2024. We have listened to the voices of many of you, we have learned from last season and we want to take the "Czech O-Tour cruise ship" one step further.

#### Without a bib

We present ourselves to be as sustainable as possible, so there will be no bib for any competitors this year. So you don't have to go to the presentation or stress about dropping yours during the race.

#### Accompanying program

Fun program for the youngest children with Str8, Sporticus labyrinth, crypto game with Cryptomania, Kubík's kindergarten and much more. We want you to enjoy the Czech O-Tour, and not only on the course. In the next part of the bulletin you will find out what we have prepared for you.

#### **Prizegiving and raffle**

In categories HDR, HD10L and DH10 we announce all competitors who were not disqualified. Besides the prizegiving there will be a raffle for very valuable prizes.

#### **Club competition**

We have modified the evaluation of Club competition. The best 12 results of one club member across 9 categories are now counted. At the same time we have prepared very interesting prizes mostly for all scorers.

#### **Central National controller**

All competitions have the same National Controller (or a Main Referee, if you like) who should set the same level of quality for all competitions and categories. The emphasis on the sportive aspects is the absolute alpha and omega of all our efforts.

# Venue: Mirakulum (Milovice)

#### **Transport and parking**

#### Where am I going and where do I park?

To the Mirakulum amusement park in Milovice! The competition arena including parking is at the edge of the venue (GPS: <u>50.2402 N, 14.8584 E</u>). Follow the instructions of the parking service.

Attention! Access from the direction of Prague / Hradec Králové / Lysá n. Labem is possible only from the D11 motorway. From the direction of Liberec (exit 27 on the D10 motorway) it is not possible to go directly to Milovice and it is necessary to take a detour, see the traffic plan.

We would like to reduce the number of cars that come to the event and help our air a little bit. At the same time, you can use the <u>carpooling table</u> to list available spots or request a spot in a car.

#### Come by train or bus!

Don't hesitate to come by train to Milovice (from Prague Masarykovo n. 7:20, 7:50, 8:20 and 8:50), from there you can walk or take a bus. You can also take a bus to the event with a change in Lysá nad Labem.

If you take the bus, please get off at the bus stop Milovice, Industrial Zone (direction from Benátky n J.) or Milovice, Sportovní (direction from the railway station). Then walk along Topolová or Tyršova streets.

The Milovice, Park Mirakulum bus stop is located in the competition area, so don't spoil your experience by unwittingly visiting it beforehand. See competition area on the map below.



#### Do I have to go to the event office?

No, anyone who has paid properly and does not want any change or to borrow a chip does <u>not need to attend the event office</u>. Any overpayments will be credited back to your account after the event. Download the documents from IS ORIS. Confirmed proof of payment will be sent upon request (info@o-tour.cz).

#### Can I or my mates go to the amusement park?

In order to maximize the number of entries who can compete at the event, we have decided as follows:

- During the day, it is strictly forbidden to enter the area of the Mirakulum theme park, except when the athlete is on the course.
- The only exception is the labyrinth near the arena, which is used for the accompanying "Sporticus labyrinth" race - be careful not to run out of it into the competition area.
- You can enter the amusement park without restrictions from 17:00 and you will be able to try all the attractions (except the water world) until 18:45. After that the park will be closed.

#### **Control descriptions**

Self-service at the assembly point by category (except for MW21 and HD21E; they are in the second cell of the starting corridor); they are also printed on the map. The loose descriptions will have a different colour for each of the stages.

#### Kubík's Kindergarten

In the event arena for the necessary time when the parents are racing, see the plan. There will be a small race. All participants can look forward to a nice gift from the mascot Kubik.



#### Str8 Adventure race for little ones (suitable for children 2+)

In the immediate vicinity of the kindergarten there will be an adventure orienteering race for the youngest children with their parents. There will be challenges inspired by the heroes of the popular series, visibility from a control to the next one, and a small reward for everyone at the finish line.

- Bring your own SI card, limited rentals will be available.
- The race can be completed once throughout the day (9:00 17:00). One minute start interval.

#### Cryptomania encryption game

During Sunday, March 24 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

There will be a crypto game that will take you about 20-30 minutes. The ciphers are better to be solved in teams. It is ideal to go to the game area in a small group of about 3-5 people. However, we won't stop anyone from trying to tackle the pitfalls of the game on their own.

The game will be suitable for either a team of adults or a group (family) of adults and children 10+.

The only equipment needed to play the game will be a mobile phone with internet access (of one of the team members).

Like orienteering, cryptography games can be practiced. For example, by solving one of the ciphers on our website <u>https://www.crypto-mania.cz/ukazky-sifer/</u> or by playing the sample online game Letter Without an Address <u>https://trails.cryptomania.cz/trail/dopis/</u>.



For each player who completes a prepared crypto game, Cryptomania will give a 20% discount on the purchase of Cryptomania games.

#### **Sporticus labyrinth**

Several courses await you within a unique natural labyrinth right next to the arena. There will be 4 courses, this time more experienced athletes will be able to enjoy it. You can get lost in the labyrinth from 9:00-17:00.

#### OB-chůdek o-shop and orienteering bazaar

The booth of <u>the Czech Orienteering Shop</u> will be open all weekend. In the <u>O-bazaar</u> you can offer your sports equipment or buy second-hand ones during the weekend.

#### WC

In the arena in sufficient quantity at two different locations

#### Changing

It is possible to set up your own club tents on the meadow near the arena (see arena plan)

#### **First Aid**

At the finish line and in the arena of both races

#### Refreshments

At the finish line water, IoniLyte ionic drink and Relax orange juice for all competitors in their own containers (finish is right in the arena).

There will be a large catering in the arena directed by Mirakula with a wide selection of refreshments (see below). Compared to the standard operation, there is a 10% discount for all participants. Please bring your own cup, cutlery or box.

# What awaits me on the course?

#### Terrain

Partly very rugged theme park (grass areas, paved paths, forest paths), partly suburban forest and forest park (terrain and vegetation details), partly meadows and semi-open areas and partly urban area (housing estates, paved areas, small parks). <u>Competition area</u>

#### Possible hazards and recommended footwear

In worse weather, the terrain in the forest part can be quite muddy, even in the area of the amusement park itself. In places there is undergrowth in the forest. In any case, we recommend wearing shoes with spikes and covering your lower legs for both stages. <u>No shoes</u> with metal spikes are allowed!

Ticks carrying Tick-borne encephalitis and Lyme-disease may be present in the forest areas.

The part of competition area in Mirakulum Park is relatively small and, despite our efforts to limit the maximum number of competitors in the area, dangerous situations or even collisions can occur. We ask for caution.

On the course you might be running and undercutting some of the attractions, which may be low in places. Watch your head. The height can vary in some attractions, it is usually between 1,65-2,00 m see photo, but you may also encounter lower obstacles, so be careful.

Some potentially dangerous low obstacles can be highlighted by yellow and black tape. Such taping is from safety reasons thus crossable.


#### **Multilevel structures**

Structures outside the running level (suspension footbridges, rope bridges, tree trails, etc.) will be mapped only at points of contact with the ground. Such entrances will generally be marked in olive on the map and marked in the field with red and white tape, see example.




Multi-level structures mapped according to ISSprOM 2019-2 can be used (see Example 1). In other cases, only one level is used and mapped. Entrances to a level that is not used for the race will be closed with red and white tape. In the case that the lower level is used for the event, they are mapped as shown in Example 2 is used.


Many thanks to our partner - Czech company Lucifer, who lent us a number of flashlights for these places. Check out their <u>website</u>, we are sure you'll find yours too. They will also have their own stand at the Czech O-Tour arena.

Some park attractions may have reduced visibility, so we will provide artificial lighting in such places. The lighting is for better orientation in space and to watch your steps. In such places it may not be possible to read the map fully.



#### Courses

For M21 and W21 15 minutes winning time. For other classes according to the table on the <u>website</u>. There will be a large number of controls in the competition area. Most of the courses on both stages have multiple self-intersections. A control number may be placed close to another control or exceptionally behind a course line. Pay attention to the control serial numbers and whether you are punching the correct controls.



#### Map flip

Categories M21/H21E and W21/D21E has a map flip in Stage 1. The first part of the course ends with a control and on the second map the course continues with the symbol 715. Make sure you start with the correct map starting with control 1. Symbol 715, indicating the first control on the other side of the map:

#### **Compulsory routes**

Start - map start and last control - finish, both marked by a corridor. The last control will be the same for both stages.

#### **Ribbon course**

Courses of the D10L, H10L and HDR categories are marked with <u>yellow and white ribbons</u>, shortening between controls is allowed. In the HDR category there are 2 maps for each entrant (1 for the competitor and 2 for the accompaniment). We urge you to complete your course first, then the HDR course.

The HDR competitors can only start from time 30 (= Stage 1: 9:30, Stage 2: 14:00).

#### Accompanying on the course

Accompaniment is only allowed in the HDR and OPEN categories. It is strictly forbidden to compete with a dog or other animal.

#### **Punching system**

Electronic SportIdent units will be set to a touch free mode including finish units (allowing punching up to 0.5 m).

In case of failure of the SI units at the controls, the competitor is obliged to mark the passage through the control by mechanical stamping into the map. The stamps are placed under the plate that holds the electronic unit or next to the electronic unit. The competitor must hand in the map with the replacement stamping for inspection at the finish. Time is measured to the nearest whole second.

#### Finish

Located in the arena. Maps will not be collected. We ask for fair play. <u>The competitor is</u> required to have his/her chip read out after finishing the race, even if he/she did not finish the race. The finish line will be closed after the time limit of the last competitor to start has elapsed.

#### **Restricted areas**

Strict prohibition of entry and overcoming of all impassable symbols according to ISSprOM 2019-2.

In exposed areas, impassable objects, closed gates, entrances to closed attractions, etc. will be highlighted with <u>red and white tape</u>.

# What about the results and the prizegiving?

#### **Preliminary results**

will be posted continuously in the arena area and available online in the OTour app or on the OResults website (<u>www.oresults.eu</u>). Final results will be posted in ORIS and on the series website.

#### Winners' announcement

The winners of both stages will be announced after the end of Stage 2 at about 17:00. All participants will be announced regardless of their ranking in the HDR, DH10L and DH10 categories. The top three in DH12, DH14A, DH14B, MW21 and the winners of the other categories.

# Kwak Czech O-Tour Stage 1: Sunday 24th March (morning) Discipline

Sprint

#### Start

00=9:00, distance 1200 m (20 m climbing), blue and white ribbons.



The competitor is obliged to CLEAR and CHECK the chip in the respective corridor. In the last corridor the competitor stands at his map without looking and starts from his/her map on the starting signal. It is not allowed to bring the map to the start line. The DH21/MW21 category maps will be placed at the front, closest to the start line.

The 3rd corridor is about 80 m long and includes a crossing of a low-traffic road, which will be guarded by the organizers. However, please take care when crossing.

The OPEN-S, OPEN-M, OPEN-L, T and HDR categories have a free start between 9:30 and 12:00; they will use the start control.

#### Start

00=13:30, distance 150 m (0 m elevation gain) on blue and white ribbons.



The competitor is obliged to CLEAR and CHECK the chip in the respective corridor. In the last corridor the competitor stands at his map and starts from his map on the starting signal. It is not allowed to bring the map to the start line. The DH21/MW21 category maps will be placed at the front, closest to the start line.

The OPEN-S, OPEN-M, OPEN-L, T and HDR categories have a free start between 14:00 and 16:30; they will use the start control.

# A few formalities at the end

The event is conducted according to the Czech Rules of Orienteering, except for M21/W21 class, where the IOF rules apply.

#### Protests

Standard complaint and protest procedure is in charge for M21/W21 classes, free of charge. Time limit for complaints is at time 152 for both Stages. The complaints are to be handed out in the Event Office.

For other categories, the charge for filing a protest is 400 CZK. Protests against the official results can be delivered to rozhodci@o-tour.cz .

#### Scope of the event

Two single-race IOF World Ranking Events in individual Sprint (M21 / W21). For other classes, we are preparing two separately ranked individual races which count towards the overall ranking of the Czech O-Tour series.

#### Notice

Everyone participates in the event at their own risk, the organizers assume no responsibility.

Sales or promotional activities may only be carried out with the approval of the plant manager.

#### Protection of personal data

The organizer, as the personal data controller, is entitled to process the personal data of the registered participant for the performance of its duties as the organizer of the event, for the purpose of fulfilling the contract concluded between the organizer and the participant upon acceptance of the application. For the purpose of fulfilling its obligations, the organiser will publish the participant's personal data in the valid CSOS format in the form of the entry form, start list and results in the ORIS information system (https://oris.orientacnisporty.cz) and on the event website (https://o-tour.cz).

#### Photography

During the event, news photographs will be taken to inform the public about the event, the settlement of subsidies for the event, etc. in accordance with Section 89 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code. In addition, photographs may be taken for the personal use of the competitors (as a memory of the race, for the promotion of your OB club), especially of the announcement of the results and the finish line. In case you do not agree to be photographed, please notify the photographer explicitly.
