A forgotten corner of Czechia offers a number of opportunities for trips and also great orienteering terrains. That is why we are pleased that more than 1500 of you will be present at the start of the Czech O-Tour.

We believe that you will be able to enjoy not only the courses, but also the accompanying program. In addition to the traditional O-bazaar or labyrinth, we can certainly recommend the Sunday GAPP photo booth, which accompanies us throughout the season. At the O-RUN stand, you will find O-Tour merchandise, so don't forget to stop by. Saturday late afternoon will belong to the lantern parade, you are invited! In addition, you can take advantage of training in the race area until Tuesday.

At the last minute, due to the ongoing construction work, we decided to move the arena from the area in Lesná about 200 meters away, to the adjacent meadow. At the same time, we had to change the end of all the courses. We realize that not everything will be ideal, but we do everything we can to make you feel as good as possible. We believe that grass instead of mud will be a pleasant change for you - but you better not forget your boots 😊.

How do I get to Lesná?

Access to Lesná (GPS: [50.5647N, 13.4310E](#)) is possible from the direction of Jirkov and Horní Jiřetín. The last 2 km of the route follows a narrow road, be careful when avoiding other vehicles.

We would like to increase the occupancy of cars that go to the races and help our atmosphere. Therefore, a weekend parking fee of CZK 100 (with 3 or more people in the car), CZK 150 (2 people in the car) and CZK 200 (alone in the car) will be charged. Parking for caravans and motorhomes is for 200 CZK / night on the [meadow](#) near the information center.

Parking areas are 300-500 m from the arena. **Departure possible only by the lower exit!**

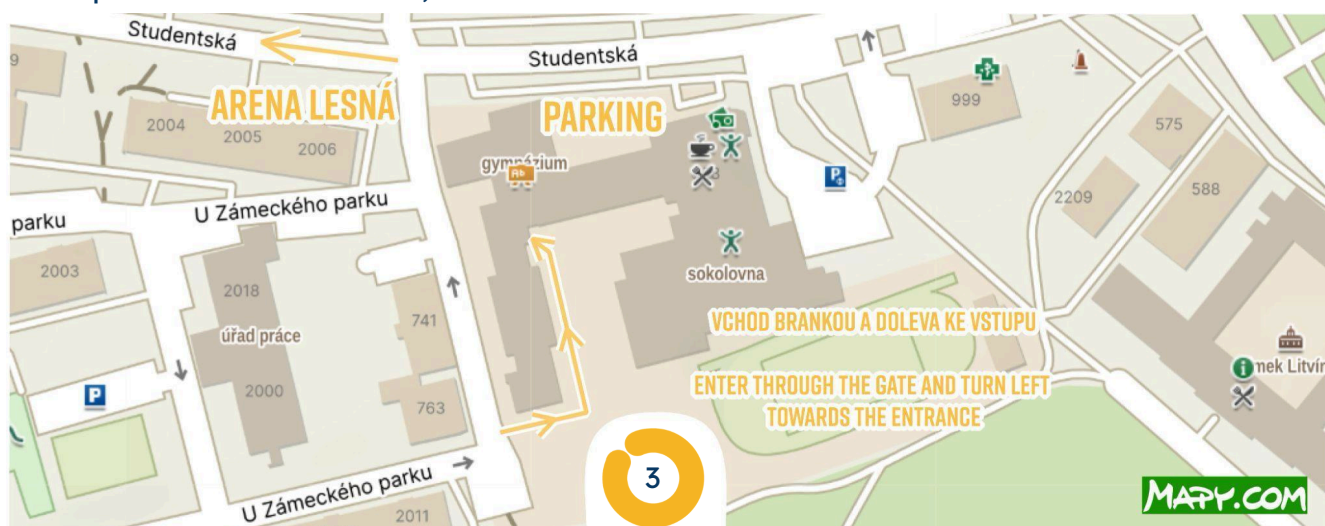

Accommodation in the gym

In the [TGM Litvínov Grammar School](#) only for pre-ordered, parking is possible in the private parking lot of the grammar school, see the map (accommodated guests will receive a confirmed parking permit), in case parking spaces run out, it is necessary to park in the vicinity of the school according to valid traffic rules. The entrance to the gym is through a side entrance (see map). There are toilets and showers.

The gym will be open on Friday by appointment (contact Jitka Pavlíková in advance), closed on Saturday at 9:00. and reopened from 18:00, on Sunday it is necessary to leave the gym by 9:00.

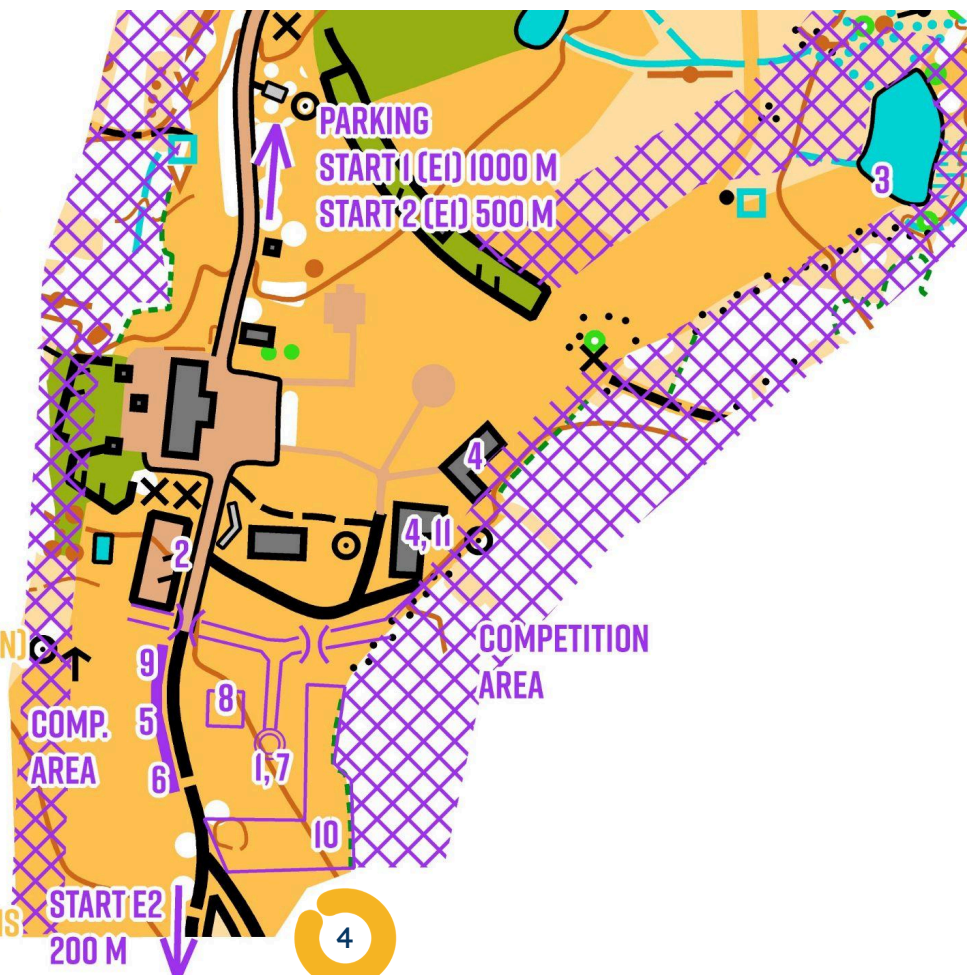

GAPP Photo Booth



Do you want to have a great photo? On Sunday, use the GAPP photo booth directly in the arena from 10:00 to 15:00.

Kubík's Children's corner



In the arena, the race for the necessary time when the parents are racing. You can make a lantern for the evening lantern parade.

Wall of Mistakes (New!)



At the finish line, you'll find a large map of the race area, where you can show off where you got lost, where you met the animals or where you got stuck in the swamp. Play fair and don't look at the map before the race.

Mini adventure race for the little ones



With accompaniment and start from the Children's Corner - on Saturday a mini orienteering with a quiz, on Sunday an animal orienteering with a crossword. A medal awaits everyone at the finish line. Bring your SI card with you!

Stage prize giving ceremony

The award ceremony will take place at 16:00 (E1) and 14:00 (E2) in the race arena. All participants (HDR, DH10F, DH10), TOP 3 (DH12, DH14A, DH14B) and winners of other categories will be awarded.

Overall GAPP Czech O-Tour 2025 series prize giving

On Sunday, the overall ranking of the GAPP Czech O-Tour 2025 series will be announced (the 7 best results are counted). The awards will be given to the best 3. We will also announce the 8 best clubs and the best man and woman of the Sporticus finish. You can find the results on the o-tourapp.cz website, where you can also register to unlock statistics.

Sporticus labyrinth

The labyrinth is here again - a new challenge and new courses every day. Both children and parents can race, there will be difficult courses and also duels.

O-bazaar is back on the scene

You can offer your sports equipment or buy new ones. You can also bring unused keychains. More information can be found on the [Czech O-Tour website](#).

Cryptomania Encryption Game



It takes about 20-30 minutes and is ideal in a team of 3-5 people. The only necessary equipment is a mobile phone with internet access. [Encryption Games](#) will also be available for purchase.

Testing Str8 Compasses



At the O-RUN stand for 80 CZK (model Str8 EVO). The number will be limited, so don't hesitate to test the speed and stability of the Str8 compass. The rental fee will be deducted from any purchased compass.

Czech Red Cross



At the finish line you will find a stand of the Czech paramedics. When they're not rescuing someone, you can check out their equipment and try first aid.

Ore Mountains Museum



You can visit the Ore Mountains Museum directly in the arena for free. You will find historical equipment and demonstrations of Ore Mountain costumes.

Catering

You can look forward to a café, cakes from the organizers, hot soups and main dishes (including vegetarian). Don't forget to bring your own cup, box and cutlery. The main catering will have two pick-up points, a large dining tent is mainly used for consumption.

Christmas gifts already in autumn?

Do you need new orienteering shoes, a compass or a headlamp? You can buy it at sports retailers O-RUN, Sporticus, Lucifer or in [the Czech Orienteering Shop](#). There will also be Czech O-Tour [merch](#) at O-RUN.

What awaits me on the course?

Start

The way to the start is marked with blue and white ribbons. Competitors start in the third corridor from their map. It is not allowed to study the map in advance or to take it to the starting line.



Map

Maps are not collected at the finish, adhere to fair play, do not show maps to competitors who have not yet started.

Extra maps ordered (for OPEN categories) will be issued at the start. It is necessary to pick up a wristband at the event office in the arena, against which the map will be issued.

Mandatory legs

Start – map start (marked with ribbons or a corridor), the last control – finish (marked with a corridor)

Categories and courses

Estimated times and categories according to the table on [the website o-tour.cz](http://the-website-o-tour.cz).

Ribbon courses (D10F, H10F, HDR)

Marked **with black and white** ribbons, shortening between controls is allowed. In the HDR category, there are 2 maps for each participant (for a competitor and an escort).

Punching and timekeeping system

SportIdent (non-contact punching up to a distance of 0.5 m). In case of a failure to mark the passage, punch with pliers on the map. Measuring time in whole seconds.

Refreshments at the finish

Water, IoniLyte ionic drink and Relax juice for all competitors (in cups). We will be happy if you use your own cup or bottle.

Time limit

90 minutes, the finish closes after the time limit of the last competitor in the start list.

Terrain

Diverse, a number of watercourses, swamps, stone walls, earth walls and isolated stones. The vegetation ranges from open areas through semi-open, clean forest to very dense spruce passages. In some parts blueberry or grass. A moderately dense network of paths. Mostly flat or gentle slope.

Restricted Areas

Private lands that are not allowed to enter during the race will be marked on the map with out-of-bounds area and **with red and white** tape in the terrain from the approach direction.

Warning (only for categories from start 1)

In the middle area, there are watercourses of different depth and width. Some are up to 3 m wide and full of standing water or covered with a layer of grass that can be fallen through.

These, potentially dangerous, watercourses or swamps are highlighted on the map by a wider blue line (0.30 mm compared to the usual 0.18 mm) - the 304 "Crossable watercourse" symbol. Be extra careful when crossing these places.



Crossing the road

Categories D21EA, H18A, H21EAB, H35A, H40 are crossing the access road to the parking lot. We don't expect much traffic, except for competitors' vehicles, so be careful anyway.

200 m (blue and white ribbons)

Classes HDR, OPEN-S/M/L, and T start from 9:00 and 11:30 and punch the start control.

Time limit

135 minutes, the finish closes after the time limit of the last competitor in the start list.

Terrain

Diverse, a number of watercourses, swamps, stone walls, earth walls, isolated stones, but also rocky areas and stone fields. The vegetation is dominated by easily runnable forest, there are also open areas, semi-open and very dense spruce passages. In some parts blueberry or grass. A moderately dense network of paths. In the western part, more gradual slopes, in the eastern part, steep slopes and stone fields.

Refreshments on the course

Longer courses have refreshment stations located at the control points, water will be available. Some shorter courses (which, according to the rules, do not have to have refreshments) may lead around control points with refreshments. They will not have such a place marked with a cup on the map.

Lantern parade

Come and enjoy the magical atmosphere of the Ore Mountains in the evening. On Saturday, about half an hour after the prize giving, we will meet at the Lucifer stand, from where we will set off for a 1.5 km long lantern parade. Lanterns can be made throughout the day in the children's corner.



Try Venku.app application

During the Czech O-Tour, you will be able to try [Venku.app](#) at Lesná. Download it to your mobile phone and you will find several control points around the arena. All you have to do is take a picture of the QR code and get points for the overall rating. You can already find Venku.app in 10 places throughout the Czech Republic.

On Sunday, you can check out the stand of the Army of the Czech Republic in the arena, including a military Toyota Hilux and a demonstration of other equipment.



Best clubs with start numbers

Not only are they fighting for the overall victory in the club competition, 2 best clubs will receive self-adhesive start numbers with their names for Saturday's race in the Ore Mountains as part of testing for the [2026 Orienteering World Cup](#).

We are preparing two separately rated individual races, which will be included in the overall ranking of the GAPP Czech O-Tour 2025 series, in the national ranking (rank. coefficient 1.00) and in the veteran ranking.

Notification

Everyone participates in the race at their own risk, the organizers do not assume any responsibility.

Sales or promotional activities are only possible with the consent of the race director.

Personal data protection

The Organiser, as a personal data controller, is entitled to process the personal data of the registered participant for the performance of his/her obligations as the organiser of the race, for the purpose of performing the contract concluded between the organiser and the participant upon acceptance of the application. For the purpose of fulfilling its obligations, the organizer will publish the participant's personal data in the valid ČSOS format, in the form of an application, start list and results in the [ORIS information system](#) and on the [o-tour.cz website](http://o-tour.cz).

Photography

During the event, news photographs will be taken to inform the public about the race, accounting for subsidies for the event, etc. in accordance with Section 89 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code. Furthermore, photos can be taken here for the personal use of competitors (as a memory of the races, for the promotion of your orienteering club), especially from the announcement of results and the finish line. If you do not agree to be photographed, please notify the photographer explicitly.
